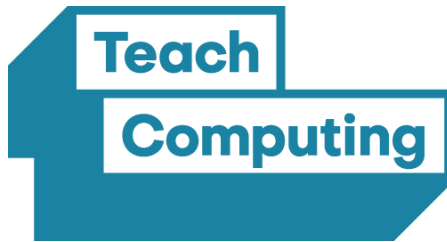




# Odyssey Computing Hub
