Senior Mental Health Lead Training Grant

Apply for a <u>senior mental health lead training</u> grant to equip your mental health lead with the knowledge and skills to implement an effective whole school or college approach to mental health and wellbeing.

All schools and colleges can <u>claim a £1,200 grant</u> by **Sunday 31 March** for their mental health lead to attend DfE quality assured training anytime in the spring or summer academic terms, 2024. The training will help your mental health lead develop your setting's holistic approach to promoting and supporting the mental health and wellbeing of pupils, learners and staff.

If you previously claimed a grant and your trained lead has left your setting, you can also now apply for a 2nd grant.


